Purpose

Wyonegonic Family Camp provides:

- an introduction to what a summer camp has to offer for families with young children
- an opportunity for families to regroup and have fun together
- a refreshing experience in the out of doors



Facilities:

Wyonegonic's extensive acreage includes over 2 miles of shoreline. Families live in rustic cabins without electricity. Toilets and hot showers are centralized. There are also a limited number of platform tents. The Wiggie serves as

the main lodge. Meals are served in the Cobb Lodge Dining Hall. Other common buildings with fireplaces are available for games, reading and socializing. Wyonegonic is a non–smoking community.

Waterfront:

The highly popular waterfront is guarded by trained lifeguards and has appropriate swimming areas for all ages and abilities. Canoes, rowboats, sailboats, kayaks, and funyaks are also available. Water skiing and sail



boarding are available for those 11 and up. We do require a swim evaluation in order to use all watercraft.

Family Camp Fees and Dates

Fees are shown, per individual, per session. There is a reduced fee for Juniors (age 5–10) and Seniors (over 65). There is no charge for children under age 5. No adjustments are made for people arriving late or departing early.

There is a housing fee per session in addition to the attendee fees listed above.

The deposit is required with registration. Cancellations after April 15th will forfeit the deposit. 50% of the attendee amount is due April 15th. The remaining 50% is due July 15th. There are no refunds for cancellations that occur after July 15th.

We encourage you to consider sharing a cabin with friends to reduce overall costs.
