## Acknowledgment and Assumption of Risks, and Agreements of Release and Indemnity

We, Camper and Parent, recognize the inherent risks of injury, and even death, involved in horseback riding generally and in learning to ride in particular. Such risks include falls and abrasions, bites, kicks, breaks and sprains, and head and other injuries associated with being on and around horses, which are unpredictable and potentially dangerous animals. Camper, and Parent for himself or herself and on behalf of the Camper, acknowledge and assume all risks of Camper's riding, jumping and moving about the horses, whether those risks are described above or not, and whether they are inherent to the Camp's horseback riding activities or not.

Parent, for himself or herself and on behalf of the Camper, voluntarily releases Wyonegonic Camps, Inc., its owners, instructors and employees from all liability and responsibility on account of any injury the Camper may sustain while receiving instruction or while riding or moving about the horses.

In addition, Parent agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Wyonegonic Camps, Inc., its owners, instructors and employees from any claim arising from such activities of the Camper, whether based on a loss suffered by or caused by the Camper.

These agreements of release and indemnity include claims of the negligence of a released or indemnified party, but not that party's gross negligence, recklessness or intentionally wrongful conduct. This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Maine, but not those laws which may apply the laws of another State.
